

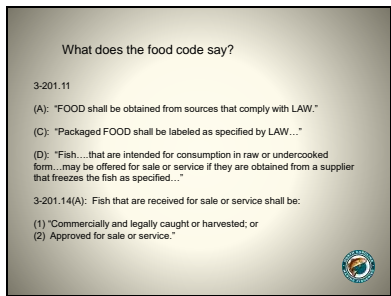

Fish Advisory Information

- Also, as important, recreationally caught fish may contain possible contaminants that may pose health risks.
- Freshwater fish that come from farm ponds, or restricted river areas can be contaminated with pesticides or other harmful substances.

The primary method by which to determine whether most seafood products originate from an approved source is by examination of invoices or receipts.

Gaining Access to Records

- 2013 Food Code, Annex 1, Compliance and Enforcement
- 8-909.10
 - The Regulatory Authority may seek access for one or more of the following purposes, according to Law for gaining access:
 - To examine the records on the premises relating to food purchased, received, or used by the food establishment

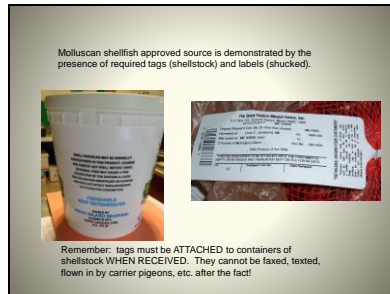
Labels on boxes or individual packages can also be helpful in determining source, but without supporting documents (invoices) source cannot be reliably determined.
